Please reconsider the recent FCC ruling on line sharing. I fear the recent ruling will adversely affect my ability to work at home, **by** discouraging DSL competition,

The choices for broadband access here in Bethesda, Maryland, are Comcast, Verizon DSL, and three or four ISPs using different CLEC's. . Since I work at home, quality internet access is very important. I've tried several different ISPs and the level of service varies widely. Comcast and Verizon's offerings are not very good, compared to what **I** have now: Speakeasy, with Covad Communications. **as** the CLEC.

I fear that the recent ruling by the FCC will hurt my choices for broadband internet access, please dont' let my only two choices be Comcast and Verizon!!!!
