

In consideration of the broadband internet access over power lines proposal, I encourage the FCC as well as any regulatory agency to consider the impact on existing and future licensed services. In this case, there seems to be much evidence of interference to amateur radio activities in areas that power line broadband internet exists or has been tried. The degree of interference renders the frequencies unusable. This is unsatisfactory. Assurances of non-interference are essential. We cannot afford to lose the amateur service. Nor, can we allow the interference to other services (maritime/aviation) that occupy spectrum that could receive harmful interference from this proposal.
