

Unless FCC is now in the process of investigating Global Crossing (GX) and its deal with STT, I am writing to protest against GX request for extension of its exclusivity period to Oct. 28 and to restructure a Stand-Alone Plan.

It is widely known to the public that this GX bankruptcy is a fraud. It is also questionable why GX allows only Hutchison/STT to bid, and now for STT to step up from a minority interest to a controlling interest after all the controversy against Hutchison.

It is reported by GlobalAxxess in their letter to your Office dated April 30, 2003 that GX is playing a procedural game, first to make it look like a small bankruptcy case, as it involves only \$250 million in the transaction, whereas it is a big swindle, the network system costs billions of dollars to build. It is clear that GX is trying to hide something from U.S. Government, claiming that Hutchison/STT is the only bidder. I am sure FCC is well aware that if this deal is approved to STT, it would put this U.S. telecommunications company assets, which are used by many government agencies like Department of Defense, into the hands of a foreign government. Consideration should be taken that this network system was built with funds from American citizens/investors and now if given to STT, a foreign entity, it would be for them to compete against U.S. telecom companies. Time is ripe for FCC to allow "NEW AMERICAN BLOOD" into this company by opening bids again.

In view of the above, FCC should not allow GX to play this procedural game by barring an extension of exclusivity period. This is also an opportunity for FCC and other Government agencies to rectify GX fraudulent BK, to prove to the investment world that there is no bias to any parties, special favor to countries and leniency to corruptions. This would be your ANSWER to the Americans - no tolerance of INJUSTICE in this free world. If no action is being taken, then I hate to say - "It's a Lame Duck Government" as they could not even protect the interest of ordinary Americans.
