
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 28, 2003, Jeff Pfaff, an attorney with Sprint Corporation, had a telephone conversation with Jared Carlson, Deputy Director of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-referenced docket.

With respect to call-back requirements for non-initialized handsets, Sprint discussed concerns with any broad network requirement as a solution to the call-back issue. Sprint noted that there was a lack of record to support a need for an additional mandate in this area. Sprint also discussed other problems stemming from the current requirement that wireless carriers transmit 911 calls originating from non-initialized handsets.
