

EX PARTE MEMORANDUM (Docket No. MB 02-235)

On May 8, and May 9, 2003, Spanish Broadcasting System, Inc. ("SBS") made ex parte presentations to the offices of Chairman Michael Powell, Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy, Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Commissioner Kevin Martin, pursuant to the Commission's Public Notice in the above-referenced docket, released August 26, 2002.

The ex parte presentations addressed questions concerning a separate Hispanic broadcast market and the adverse impact upon that market that would result from a Commission grant of the merger of Hispanic Broadcasting Corporation and Univision Communications, Inc. Inter alia, SBS showed that Commission approval of the merger would result in the elimination of competitive voices in the marketplace and the reduction of minority ownership in broadcast media.
