Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 29, 2003, Stu Overby and Bruce Oberlies of Motorola, Inc., met with Julius Knapp, Rashmi Doshi, Dave Means and William Hurst of the Office of Engineering and Technology as well as Herb Zeiler of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss the technical standards applicable to public safety and private wireless licensees operating in the 150-174 MHz, 421-512 MHz and 700 MHz bands that are the subject of the two proceedings referenced above.

Motorola sought staff clarification of some of the provisions contained in the Second Report and Order in WT Docket No. 99-87.¹ Motorola also discussed its positions expressed in its recently filed petition for reconsideration in WT Docket No. 96-86.²
