

As stated in the explanation of our Appeal to USAC-SLD (*Attachment B*), a data entry error occurred upon the original submission of our Form 471, which indicated only one month of Internet service. A corrected invoice was submitted indicating that service was being provided for twelve months.


In an email from Mr. Noel O'Flannigan dated September 20, 2002 (*Attachment C*), Mr. O'Flannigan did state that he was not permitted to increase the amount of an FRN. However, Mr. O'Flannigan never advised us that we should submit a revised Form 471 to cover the additional 11 months of Internet service, which was the reason USAC-SLD, disapproved our appeal.

Fortunately, the Arizona Educational Network, our Internet Provider, has continued to provide us with Internet access pending the approval of this appeal. Since our curriculum integrates the Internet into daily lessons, it would have been detrimental to our students' learning process and graduation if Internet service had been discontinued.

Attachment D is the Revised Form 471 for Funding Year 5. It was submitted as a Revision to FY6 Form 471 because this was the only option available. We have made the corrections to the paper copy indicating that it is a Revised Form 471 for FY5, 7/1/02-6/30/03. The corrections were sent to USAC-SLD on May 22, 2003.



After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division ("SLD") of the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") has made its decision in regard to your appeal of SLD's Year 2002 Funding Commitment Decision for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of SLD's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60-day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). If your letter of appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that for each application for which an appeal is submitted, a separate letter is sent.

Funding Request Number: 821254
Decision on Appeal: **Denied in full**
Explanation:

- In your appeal you stated that the FCDL approved the FRN as submitted, which only included one month's service. You also stated that a data entry error occurred upon originally submitting the Form 471 online and that the correct invoice was submitted indicating that the service was being provided for twelve months. You are therefore requesting that SLD fund the remaining eleven months accordingly.
- Upon thorough review of your appeal, it has been determined that the online Form 471 submission for FRN 821254 did indeed request an annual non-recurring amount of \$6,775.00. The PIA reviewer properly conveyed to you that the initial Form 471 request amounts couldn't be increased. The application was properly processed based on your submission of an annual non-recurring amount of \$6,775.00.


- Your appeal requests additional funds that were not included in the Form 471 in regard to which you are appealing SLD's funding decision. FCC rules require that funding requests be made on Forms 471. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.504. Funding requests may not be made on appeals of SLD funding commitment decisions. Whether your request can be considered for funding will depend on the date your Form 471 is received and, if it is received after the close of the filing window, whether funds are available. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.507(g). Consequently, SLD denies your appeal insofar as it requests funding not requested in the Form 471, which forms the basis of this appeal.

If you believe there is a basis for further examination of your application, you may file an appeal with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) via United States Postal Service: FCC, Office of the Secretary, 445-12th Street SW, Washington, DC 20554. If you are submitting your appeal to the FCC by other than United States Postal Service, check the SLD web site for more information. 

This appeal is submitted in accordance with the guidelines listed under Rule #2 of the *Appeals - SLD Guidelines for Review*. The FCDL approved the FRN as submitted, which only included one month's service. A data entry error was committed when the Form 471 was originally submitted online however, the correct invoice was submitted indicating that the service was being provided for 12 months. As shown in Mr. Noel O'Flannigan, Reviewer, Schools and Libraries, comments in the attached e-mail, it was obvious during his review of the invoice submitted that the **monthly** amount should have been \$6,775 rather than a non-recurring charge of \$6,775. Mr. O'Flannigan goes on to state that as a reviewer he was not permitted to increase the amount of the FRN. Therefore, we request that we be funded in the amount of \$81,300.00 (our pre-discount amount) which would make our funding commitment decision \$65,040 based on our approved discount percentage of 80%.



Thank you for the information you provided on your 471 application # 308245 for Funding Year 2002. This is a formal notice of an extension of time to respond to the additional information needed (below) to complete the initial review. At this point, program guidelines require that you provide a complete response to this information request within 7 calendar days, by close of business on September 27, 2002, or we will be obligated to proceed with the review of your application with the information that we have available to us.

- 1) Qwest local service your funding request is for \$3,965 but the bills you submitted total \$3,620.82 (less ineligible voice mail totaling \$40.05). The revised invoice submitted more accurately reflects the projected monthly costs. However, the invoice submitted reflects a one month sampling and is an estimate as required by program guidelines. Please see attached Excel spreadsheet.
- 2) Qwest for T1 service your funding request is for \$3,353 but the bills you submitted total \$2,743. The revised invoice submitted more accurately reflects the projected monthly costs. However, the invoice submitted reflects a one month sampling and is an estimate as required by program guidelines. Please see attached Excel spreadsheet.

Program rules allow schools to request the funds they justifiably believe they will require for the Funding Year. Justification for the

requested amount can include past invoices or vendor proposals and can additionally identify expected increases based on verifiable changes that will take place during the Funding Year. That change should be something that subsequent audits could verify (e.g., an expected higher volume of services (supported by rationale), vendor-documented price increases, new school construction, new phone lines, increased internet use based on curriculum changes, etc.

I understand this should have been a monthly amount of \$6,775 rather than a non-recurring charge of \$6,775, however, after the 471 is filed, we are not permitted to increase the amount of an FRN. This was obviously a data entry error. Please note that the invoice/proposal from Arizona Educational Network did list the correct monthly charges and that this error is clearly grounds for the granting of an appeal according to rule two of the Appeals - SLD Guidelines for Review document. I would also like to point out that although we have not received e-rate funding, we have continued to pay Arizona Educational Network, our Internet Provider, in order to keep our Internet Access alive. Internet access is a very important part of our school curriculum would severely instruction if access was cutoff. If there is anything you can do at this stage in the process to approve funding for this FRN (assuming it meets all other criteria and funding guidelines) it would be greatly appreciated. Going through a separate appeal process and possibly delaying funding another 2-3 months would be devastating.


