PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 299A at Groesbeck, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 299A to Groesbeck, Texas as that community's first local FM service. Groesbeck, Texas is an incorporated city with a population of 4,291 people.¹ Groesbeck has its own mayor, Mike McLelland, its own post office, fire department, city hall, schools and several local churches. Groesbeck is a community that is certainly deserving of local FM service. The proposed channel 299A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Groesbeck residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 299A can be allocated to Groesbeck, Texas, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).





