I have obtained, what looks like, a good coordinate for Signal Peak, Utah at 38° 37' 32" N 112° 0' 56" W. This site is 287.9 km from KBKL, 300CØ (100 kW ERP @ 445 m HAAT), Grand Junction, Colorado, and 294.5 km from KUDD, 300C, Roy, Utah. For a Salina, Utah 300C, I need to have a minimum separation of 281 km from KBKL and 290 km from KUDD.

I have sent a letter to the Superintendent, Fishlake National Forest, requesting a statement of understanding, that if the FCC approves the construction permit, that Signal Peak will be available for the Salina, Utah 300C main transmitter site, and that Mount Terrill and White Pine Peak will be available for booster stations. This will be similar to what I would have had with my Salina, Utah 276C proposal with the main transmitter site on Mount Terrill, and the booster station on White Pine Peak.

If KBKL decides to upgrade to Class C, they would need to change channel. At that time, I will move the Salina, Utah 300C main transmitter site to Mount Terrill.

I will submit an application for construction permit for the Salina, Utah allotment.
