Today, Richard Juhnke and I met with Jeffrey Carlisle, Tamara Preiss, Rob Tanner, Aaron Goldberger and Jennifer McKee, all of the Wireline Competition Bureau, to discuss the appropriate regulatory treatment of voice over IP (VoIP) traffic. Sprint's comments were consistent with points raised in its pleadings on this issue in WC Docket No. 02-361. We urged quick resolution of the AT&T petition for declaratory ruling, and suggested that the Commission institute a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to consider regulatory treatment of VoIP traffic that involves net protocol conversion.
