I am expressly against the granting of the authority for the Utility Companies to use their power lines for Broadband Internet Service.

Tests made by the American Radio Relay League have proven that Broadband Over Powerlines will cause harmful interference to all portions of the radio spectrum by making the utility's wires a radiator which filters will not be able to suppress. The power lines are an unshielded source which will radiate noise into all frequencies of the radio spectrum.

As a licensed Radio Amateur I have been battling with the local utility company to clean up their power grid for over three years. I am opposed to adding another problem which will further degrade my enjoyment of my hobby.

I urge the Federal Communications Commission to deny the the Utility Companies permission to use their transmission lines for Broadband Services.
