ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S
NOTICE OF DEPOSITION UPON ORAL EXAMINATION

1. The Enforcement Bureau (the "Bureau"), pursuant to Section 1.315(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.315(a), hereby gives notice that it intends to take the deposition upon oral examination of Gene Chill of Business Options, Inc. ("BOI"), 8380 Louisiana Street, Merrillville, Indiana 46410-6312. Included in BOI's December 9, 2002, response to a Bureau letter of inquiry dated November 1, 2002, was an unsigned letter dated December 4, 2002, bearing Mr. Chill's name. The letterhead identifies Mr. Chill as Buzz Telecom's Vice President of Administration. In response to the Bureau's Admission Request number 26, BOI admitted that Gene Chill was BOI's Vice President of Administration on December 4, 2002. Finally, BOI's answer to the Bureau's interrogatory number 3, filed June 13, 2003, states that Gene Chill wrote responses to four questions posed in a November 1, 2002, Bureau letter of inquiry to BOI.

2. Mr. Chill will be examined before a notary public or other person authorized to administer oaths on July 17, 2003, beginning at 9:30 a.m. Merrillville, Indiana local time at the


