

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 300A at Oakwood, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 300A to Oakwood, Texas as that community's first local FM service. Oakwood, Texas is an incorporated city with a population of 471 people.¹ Oakwood has its own mayor, Dorthy Bell, its own post office, volunteer fire department, city offices, its own elementary and high school and a number of local churches. Oakwood is a community that is certainly deserving of local FM service. The proposed channel 300A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Oakwood residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 300A can be allocated to Oakwood, Texas, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).




