E-911 Interim Report

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This report is being submitted pursuant to the requirements of the Commission's Order to Stay (CC Docket No. 94-102), FCC 02-210, released July 26, 2002 ("Stay Order") and the recently issued Public Notice, entitled "Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Provides Further Guidance on Interim Report Filings by Small Sized Carriers," Mimeo DA 03-2113, released June 30, 2003.

The Filer, WUE, Inc., is a Tier III non-nationwide Commercial Mobile Radio Service carrier who was specifically granted relief in the Stay Order. The information is presented in the format specified by the Commission, as follows:

A) The Number Of Phase I And Phase II Requests From PSAPs (including those the carrier may consider invalid): The Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP") in the Filer's service area is the Lincoln County (Nevada) Sheriff's Office. The Filer has not received any requests for Phase I or Phase II E-911 service. In addition, the Filer has been advised by the PSAP that, due to budgetary and other financial constraints, it is unlikely that the Filer will receive any PSAP requests for Phase I or Phase II E-911 service.

B) The Carrier's Specific Technology Choice (i.e., network-based or handset-based solution, as well as the type of technology used): The Filer intends to employ the same E-911 solution deployed by Verizon Wireless ("Verizon") in the latter's Las Vegas, Nevada MSA Frequency Block B cellular system. The switching functions for the Filer's system are performed by Verizon's Las Vegas MSA switch. As the Filer understands it, Verizon intends to deploy a network Assisted Global Positioning

System/Advanced Forward Link Trilateration ("AGPS/AFLT") handset-based solution for E-911 Phase II location technology.

C) Status Of Ordering And/Or Installing Necessary Network Equipment: To date, the Filer has not ordered any E-911 network equipment.


D) If The Carrier Is Pursuing A Handset-Based Solution, Include Information On Whether ALI-Capable Handsets Are Now Available, And Whether the Carrier has Obtained ALI-Capable Handsets Or Has Agreements In Place To Obtain These Handsets: The Filer operates a small, stand-alone analog cellular system which serves a sparsely populated rural area. The Filer's service area covers a portion of the Nevada 5 - White Pine RSA. To date, the Filer has no agreements in place with handset manufacturers to obtain ALI-capable handsets. The Filer is aware that Motorola manufactures and sells at least one ALI-capable handset, which is marketed at Verizon retail outlets. The Filer refers customers to the Verizon retail outlets to purchase ALI-capable subscriber equipment. This is because, as a large carrier purchasing many handsets, Verizon can obtain the handsets from the manufacturer at a better bulk price than the Filer would be able to secure.

E) The Estimated Date On Which Phase II Service Will First Be Available In The Carrier's Network: Since the Filer has not received a PSAP request for Phase II E-911 service, the Filer is unable to estimate the date on which Phase II service will first be available in the Filer's service area.

F) Information On Whether The Carrier Is On Schedule To Meet The Ultimate Implementation Date Of December 31, 2005: To the best of the Filer's knowledge, it is presently on schedule to meet the December 31, 2005 ultimate implementation date.


