Pursuant to FCC staff request, Litchfield County Cellular, Inc. (“Litchfield”), by its attorneys, hereby submits this letter, informing the Commission that it is fully compliant with its obligations to be capable of transmitting calls for 911 emergency calling from text telephone (“TTY”) devices.

Litchfield is the licensee of Station KNKN787 in the Block B portion of the Kentucky 11 Clay RSA. On June 28, 2002, Litchfield submitted a timely request with the Commission for a limited waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the Commission’s rules to meet the June 30, 2002 deadline for digital wireless systems to be TTY compliant (“Waiver Petition”). On December 31, 2002, an Addendum was filed requesting until March 31, 2003 to complete installation of the necessary hardware and software at its switch to comply with the Commission’s rules. Litchfield was able to install the necessary hardware and software within the time frame established by its Addendum and is fully TTY compliant.
