On July 29, 2003, Caressa D. Bennet, representing the Rural Telecommunications Group ("RTG"), met with Joel Taubenblatt and Eugenie Barton of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-captioned proceeding. RTG discussed the unique circumstances rural wireless carriers face in the implementation of Phase II E911 and the need for the Commission to consider an accuracy standard that takes into account the network realities of providing Phase II E911 in remote rural areas where cellular towers a far apart and triangulation to locate an emergency caller becomes technically impossible.
