
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 1, 2003, Richard B. Salzman, Senior Vice President and General Counsel of TracFone Wireless Corporation, met with Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor, Office of Chairman Michael Powell. This meeting was held during the Rural Cellular Association Accounting and Finance Conference at Colorado Springs, Colorado.

During this meeting, Mr. Salzman reiterated the positions that TracFone has taken in its filed comments and prior ex partes in the Universal Service Contribution Methodology proceeding. In particular, Mr. Salzman informed Mr. Tramont that evidence on the record indicated that the revenue-based contribution methodology as modified in December 2002 would produce sufficient funds for universal service for at least the next several years. They also discussed the timing of any possible further actions on matters involving Universal Service contribution methodologies.
