

I support fully the well founded Comment submitted by The American Radio Relay League concerning Docket ET 03-104. I am genuinely concerned that Broadband over Power Line technology (BPL) poses an RFI threat to the Ham Radio Service that exists between 1.8 MHz and 80 MHz.

Given the problems electric utilities face today, now is not the right time to scope of service. There are numerous flaws in the deregulated electric utility system that need to be ironed out. The time spent ironing out these flaws can be well spent conducting further research in BPL technology so to insure there is no RFI threat to other radio services.

I believe that approval of ET 03-104 would violate the existing FCC rules on non-interference and would be contrary to the best interest of the public.
