

Members of the Commission:

As the filing date for BPL draws to a close, I trust you have had sufficient technical input to realize this proposal is counter-productive.

Independent field tests, by outside observers in the US as well as in other countries, have determined that BPL generates EMI throughout the HF spectrum. This will cause massive problems to IF amplifiers operating in this range (present TV for example) as well as 'legally jamb' the reception of international broadcasts in the HF spectrum.

Please ask yourself, why have other governments considered the adoption of BPL not technically sound? Is the US going to adopt a policy that will reduce our ability to import or export communication equipment because it is non-compatible with the EU, a non-BPL environment?

I respectfully request that you vote no on this adoption.

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
