SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

1. On April 24, 2003, the predecessor to KAGM, LLC,¹ licensee of Station KAGM(FM), Strasburg, Colorado, and On-Air Family, LLC, licensee of Station KBRU-FM, Fort Morgan, Colorado, by their respective counsel, filed a Petition for Rule Making to, inter alia, change the communities of license for Stations KAGM and KBRU-FM to Greenwood Village and Strasburg, Colorado, respectively.

2. By this Supplement, Station KBRU-FM requests a change in its coordinates for its proposal to become licensed to Strasburg, Colorado. This amended site is the allocation site specified in its pending application (BPH-20020813ABJ). The attached channel study demonstrates that from the reference coordinates all spacing requirements are met provided Station KTUN, Eagle, Colorado downgrades from Channel 268C to 269C1 at a new transmitter site as previously requested in paragraph 7, page 11 of the Petition and Station KOLT,


Bridgeport, NE is reclassified from Channel 267C to 267C0 with its existing facility. See attached letter in Exhibit A.² See attached Engineering Exhibit.

3. The Engineering Exhibits also contains a coverage map which demonstrates that there will be no loss area created by the proposed change in class and community of license for Station KRBU-FM from the new coordinates. There will be a net gain area of 685,513 person in an area of 23,959 sq. km.

4. In addition, the proposed coordinates stated in paragraph 11 on page 13 of the Petition for Station KARS-FM, Laramie, Wyoming were incorrect. The correct coordinates of 40-53-55/105-42-31 were provided in Figure 16 of the Engineering Exhibit.

The Joint Parties request that the Commission consider these changes as part of the Petition for Rule Making and issue a Notice of Proposed Rule Making expeditiously.

Amendment


The reference site for the reallocation of KBRU-FM, Fort Morgan, Colorado to the new community of Strasburg, Colorado as 268C, is amended to the site specified in the pending application for KBRU-FM (BPH-20020813ABJ).

This one-step application specified 39-51-39 North Latitude, 103-51-44 West Longitude as the allotment reference for the 268C channel upgrade.


The petition seeking the reallocation to Strasburg should have the same reference site. A channel study and coverage map at the amended site are attached and show the KBRU can be allotted to Strasburg, Colorado in compliance with Section 73.207 and 73.315.

In addition, the interference-free coverage of the present licensed site for KBRU is contained entirely within the proposed 268C interference-free coverage. As such, there is no loss area. Strasburg, Colorado is not within any US Census Urbanized Area and from the amended site the proposed 70 dBu contour will not cover any part of a US Census Urbanized Area.

Finally, as to the additional area and population to be served by the KBRU reallocation, the existing KBRU licensed facility serves 26,427 persons in an area of 2,516 square kilometers. The proposed reallocation would serve 711,940 persons in an area of 26,475 square kilometers. Thus, the reallocation will result in a net additional service to 685,513 persons in an area of 23,959 square kilometers.


