**MOTION TO WITHDRAW RESPONSE TO
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Route 66 Broadcasting, LLC ("Route 66"), licensee of Station KZKE, Channel 277A, Seligman, Arizona (Facility ID No. 56339), hereby moves to withdraw its Response to Order to Show Cause ("Response") filed in this proceeding on June 19, 2003.

Background. Liberty Ventures III, LLC ("Liberty") filed a Petition for Rule Making asking the FCC to allot Channel 285A to Ash Fork, Arizona, as a first local service. In response, the staff issued the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making* (the "NPRM"), 67 Fed. Reg. 5961 (2002).

NPR Phoenix, LLC ("NPR") timely advanced a counterproposal that entailed, among other things, the displacement of Station KZKE from Channel 277A to another Class A channel with no change in Station KZKE's licensed transmitter site.

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
NPR subsequently modified its proposal to eliminate mutual exclusivity with a counterproposal filed by Spectrum Scan, LLC. NPR and Spectrum Scan filed a proposed Global Resolution in Joint Reply Comments.

On May 5, 2003, the FCC issued an *Order to Show Cause* directed to Route 66 in connection with this proceeding. The Commission proposed to move Station KZKE to Channel 227A. Thereafter, Route 66 filed its above-referenced Response.

Request to Withdraw Response. Route 66 has reached an agreement with NPR concerning reimbursement of Route 66's expenses, and Route 66 is willing to accede to the proposed channel substitution at Seligman. Therefore, Route 66 now seeks to withdraw its Response. The provisions of Section 1 420(j) do not apply to this request.

Conclusion. For the reasons stated above, the FCC should promptly adopt a *Report and Order* consistent herewith.

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
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
