Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's *ex parte* rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter is to notify you that on August 19, 2003, Scott R. Flick, representing Univision Communications Inc. ("Univision"), met with Stacy Robinson, Legal Advisor on mass media affairs to Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy, to discuss the pending application in the above-referenced proceeding. In this meeting, Univision discussed the delay in the processing of the merger application and the timetable for release of a decision by the Commission, as well as Univision's concern over efforts by competitors to use the Commission's processes to gain a competitive advantage by urging the Commission to impose conditions on the merger that have no public interest benefits and are unsupported by the record. In particular, Univision discussed the lack of a factual or legal basis for the imposition of any conditions.
