RESPONSE OF LINDA CRAWFORD**



1. I stand by the statements I made in the pleading I filed in this proceeding on July 5, 2003 titled "Response to Reply Comments of New Ulm Broadcasting".

2. The engineering exhibit that New Ulm puts forward to demonstrate that the town of Schulenburg is totally "white Area", no radio service at all, is a completely inadequate exhibit, the map is too small, the details too obscure, the town of Schulenburg is not even identified.

3. It does appear that channel 260A, KTXM/Hallettsville does provide some if not complete coverage to Schulenburg. (See, Attachment B)

4. At no time in this proceeding has New Ulm provided a detailed exhibit of the proposed "white area" and the population within that "white area". Why is that?

5. Additionally, the new Ulm counterproposal was fatally flawed as a result of its reliance on a new "backfill" FM allotment to "preserve" the city of New Ulm's sole local transmission service.





(1.0 mv coverage provided by KTXM/ Hallettsville, TX)

Note: The 1.00 mv distance to contour for station KTXM fm/ Hallettsville was computed with the FCC's FM and TV Propagation Curves calculations using an ERP of 3.40 kW and a HAAT of 106.0 meters. Based on these numbers, KTXM provides a 1.00 mv distance to contour of 25.603 km. Using KTXM's licensed coordinates of 29 27 45/ 96 56 04, KTXM provides 1.00 mv coverage to most if not all of the town of Schulenburg.


