DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 289A to Robert Lee, Texas as that community's first local FM service Robert Lee, Texas is an incorporated community with a population of 1,171 people<sup>1</sup> Robert Lee has its own mayor, Garland Davis, its own volunteer fire department, post office, and library As of the last quarter of 2000, 67 businesses in Robert Lee have been given a credit rating by Dun & Broadstreet<sup>2</sup> Robert Lee is a community that is certainly deserving of local FM service The proposed channel 289A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Robert Lee residents and therefore is in the public interest

Should this petition be granted and Channel 289A be allotted to Robert Lee, Texas, Petitioner will apply for Channel 289A at Robert Lee and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility
