On September 11, 2003, Cronan O'Connell, representing Qwest Communications International Inc., met with the following FCC members: Sheryl Wilkerson Legal Advisor on Wireless and International Issues to Chairman Powell, Trey Hanbury, of the Office of General Counsel and Jennifer Tomchin of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss intermodal telephone local number portability ("LNP") issues including: 1) the procedural steps the FCC must first take were they to change the rules for LNP that are in place today; 2) the technical burdens involved in any changes from the rules today; 3) and the competitive inequities for all providers who implemented LNP according to the Commission's rules, in effect since 1996. The discussion was consistent with Qwest's comments and *ex partes* as filed on the record.
