A letter to Mr. Michael Powell

My reason for writing is to express my concern at the proposed easing of the current controls in place for Media Outlet Ownership

The very idea that a select group of businesses with large media holdings can preserve the rights of individual free speech and freedom of the press is ludicrous! The mega-conglomerates now own large swaths of communication outlets i.e., AOL Time Warner owns networks, cable stations, magazines, and the largest Internet provider in the United States. Clear Channel is busily scooping up radio stations nation wide and instead of offering local interest broadcasts with news and home grown bands, we are subjected to the same homogenized sound across the dial. What is the competition? Where is the competition that allows the public interest to be better served?

I've heard many individuals state that the rules need to be eased due to the fact that they were originally drafted in the 60's and 70's -- before the technological explosion that exists today occurred. If that's the case then let us cast aside the Constitution as well—it was drafted in the late 1700's and did not begin to imagine the world in which we currently reside. Yet that piece of parchment has served as the foundation of our government and a guide for the American way of life.

In the early days of media, it was believed that the media owners had to serve the public good, providing local news, showing differing opinions of news topics, and protecting the rights of journalists to break news that may not be complimentary to their stations or our government—thus giving the public a better understanding of their world and allowing them the ability to form their own opinions. Today, artists are banned from media outlets for stating their opinions (even though these rights are protected by our constitution) because one company has the ability to control so many pieces of the media pie. The news available is tabloid tasting and extremely skewed depending on the nearby market and we find newspapers and television stations all fighting to catch people's attention—worried about their market share instead of reporting.

I urge you in the strongest language possible to consider the public good, not the business benefit when contemplating this change. Deregulation has not always worked in our best interest in the past and such a step, once taken, is impossibly difficult to change.

There must be no relaxing of media ownership rules.

On the contrary, the FCC should require the reversal of the trend toward consolidation. A case in point is the media giant Clear Channel Communications whose domination of radio have homogenized the airwaves. Another example of this distortion is the plan of Rupert Murdoch (an Australian citizen, incidentally) to purchase DirecTV, opening the door to TV becoming an outpost of the Murdoch empire.

Democracy is built on the idea that the view and beliefs of an informed citizenry are the best basis for political decision-making. Without access to fair and balanced news, the political system simply doesn't work.

Media corporations cannot be trusted to balance themselves. They have shown, again and again, that they're willing to sacrifice journalism to improve the bottom line. That's why we need many media entities - to keep each other honest and to provide the information and ideas that make democracy happen.

Monopoly power is a dangerous thing, and the FCC and Congress are supposed to guard against it. You must support a diverse, competitive media landscape.

You must delay any ruling for 60 days during which time more public hearings will be held.

The process of your decision-making must become transparent, with drafts made public and subject to debate.


