

**Statement of Continued Expression of Interest in Petition
for Rule Making for Millerton, Oklahoma (RM-10577)**

I, Jeraldine Anderson, declare under penalty of perjury that on October 11, 2002, I expressed my willingness to support an alternative proposal put forth by Radio One in the Valliant, Oklahoma proceeding (01-216) and the Broken Bow, Oklahoma proceeding (01-209). That alternative proposal would have required the dismissal of my undocketed petition for Channel 265A at Millerton, Oklahoma which I filed on November 9, 2001, RM-10577. (See, Attachment A)

The FCC has since then issued Report & Orders for 01-216¹ and 01-209² and did not use the alternative proposal put forth by Radio One which would have require the dismissal of my undocketed petition for Channel 265A at Millerton, Oklahoma. Therefore, I want to make it clear that I still have an expression of interest in Channel 265A at Millerton, Oklahoma and that should this petition be granted, and Channel 265A be allotted to Millerton, Oklahoma, I will apply for Channel 265A at Millerton and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.



PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Jeraldine Anderson respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 265A at Millerton, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 265A to Millerton, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Millerton has a population in excess of 300 people. Millerton has its own Mayor, Buck Irwin, its own volunteer fire department, its own post office, and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 265A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Millerton residents and therefore is in the public interest.


