Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 1, 2003, F.J. Pollak, President and CEO of TracFone Wireless, Inc. ("TracFone") and Richard B. Salzman, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of TracFone held meetings with Commissioner Kevin Martin and with Bryan Tramont of Chairman Powell's staff. These meetings were held during the PCIA Wireless Infrastructure Conference in Hollywood, Florida.

During these meetings, Mr. Pollak and Mr. Salzman reiterated the positions that TracFone has taken in its filed comments and prior ex partes in the Universal Service Contribution Methodology proceeding. In particular, TracFone representatives emphasized that any connection-based or telephone number-based contribution methodology would harm lower income and lower volume consumers. They also discussed TracFone's support for the elimination of the wireless safe harbor as well as support for additional measures to expand the contribution base.
