
This case was contingently scheduled for hearing on January 13, 2004. *See Order* FCC 03M-25, released July 3, 2003. The hearing is contingent upon approval of pending assignment applications. *Id.* Review of the applications was awaiting release of definitive ownership rules. The release of those rules is now delayed by court order staying the effective date of the Commission's new ownership rules, and ordering that prior ownership rules remain in effect pending resolution of those proceedings. *See Prometheus Radio Project v. FCC* (No. 03-3388), United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, *Order* dated August 22, 2003.

The status of review of the assignment applications of Family Broadcasting, Inc. should be reviewed in light of these developments. Further, an unrelated case on the docket of the Presiding Judge has required a new hearing date in January. *See Business Options, Inc.*, *Order* FCC 03M-36, released September 2, 2003, setting hearing date for January 13, 2004.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the conference set for December 16, 2003, and the hearing set in this case for January 13, 2004, ARE CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties SHALL SUBMIT a Status Report on Assignments on **September 23, 2003, by 2:00 p.m.**
