LDMI Telecommunications, Inc. ("LDMI") files this supplemental letter in response to the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") September 30, 2003 Public Notice seeking comment on the last-minute proposal by SBC Communications, Inc. to alter its collocation power practices in Indiana and Ohio.¹ Under a separate filing with Allegiance Telecom, Inc., LDMI details its specific concerns with SBC's proposal.

The purpose of this letter is to inform this Commission that SBC has not made this same proposal to CLECs in Michigan. It is telling that this concession, which SBC clearly deems to be necessary to meet its checklist obligations, has been denied to CLECs in Michigan. SBC also should be required to offer to CLECs in Michigan the same concessions it makes in this proceeding coupled with the additional recommendations made by Allegiance and LDMI. SBC's concession in this proceeding, despite its protestations otherwise, is a clear admission that it feels its collocation power pricing may not comport with the Commission's pricing rules. Thus, the fact that CLECs in Michigan have still not been offered this concession means they must continue to pay above-cost prices for collocation power. The fact that SBC has made no secret of the fact that it intends to ride the coattails of its Michigan approval in this proceeding

counsel all the more for requiring SBC to offer CLECs in Michigan the same collocation power pricing options that CLECs in the other Ameritech states enjoy.

LDMI respectfully requests that in addition to the recommendations that LDMI makes in its joint filing with Allegiance, the Commission should require SBC to offer its collocation power proposal, as supplemented by the Allegiance/LDMI recommendations, in Michigan.
