This letter serves as notification that on Friday, October 24, 2003, Len Lauer, President and Chief Operating Officer of Sprint Corporation and Luisa Lancetti, Vice President – Wireless Regulatory Affairs of Sprint, had separate meetings with Chairman Powell and Sheryl Wilkerson, Senior Legal Advisor to the Chairman; and with Commissioner Martin, to discuss pending issues in the above referenced proceeding.

Sprint discussed its LNP implementation efforts and provided information regarding industry-wide testing and systems readiness efforts; Sprint also discussed its views regarding the need for meaningful LEC-CMRS porting in November. Sprint discussed the importance of inter-modal competition and the role wireless can play in providing facilities-based competition and customer choice. Sprint further advised that there is no technical feasibility issue with requiring LECs to permit their customers to port to LNP-capable wireless carriers, in cases where the wireless carrier provides service at the same location where the LEC customer receives service.
