On October 29, 2003, on behalf of Time Warner Telecom (“TWTC”), I discussed the application of carrier access charges to voice over IP (“VoIP”) with Dan Gonzalez, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Kevin Martin. During our discussion, I stated that the FCC should establish clear rules as quickly as possible regarding the application of carrier access charges to VoIP. I argued that the FCC should address this issue in an order (addressing the AT&T Petition regarding the application of carrier access charges to phone-to-phone VoIP) and a policy statement (regarding all other types of VoIP).
