Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, this letter is to provide notice of an *ex parte* meeting in the above-referenced proceedings. On November 10, 2003, Amy Wolverton, Associate Legal Counsel and Media Program Director of the Campaign Legal Center (CLC), met with Johanna Shelton, Media/Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein.

During this meeting, Ms. Wolverton highlighted CLC's concern with the minimal amount of broadcast news coverage of campaign and election issues and candidates. While recognizing that some networks are promising to address upcoming elections, she urged the Commission to formally challenge broadcast and cable outlets to increase coverage of campaign and candidate issues. Ms. Wolverton also generally discussed other issues of interest to CLC, including the pending localism notice of inquiry and candidate awareness of the Commission's political broadcasting regulations.
