


This is in response to a petition for rule making that you filed on September 16, 2003, proposing the allotment of Channel 283A at Binger, Oklahoma. To accommodate the allotment at Binger, you also requested the substitution of Channel 281C0 for Channel 281C, modification of the license for Station KMGL at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to specify operation on the lower class channel and proposed a new site for vacant Channel 283C1 at Mooreland, Oklahoma.

On October 9, 2003, you submitted a motion to dismiss the petition for rule making at Binger, Oklahoma, stating that you have decided not to pursue an FM allotment for the community at this time. In compliance with Section 1.420(j) of the Commission's Rules, you have provided an affidavit stating that you will not receive, either directly or indirectly, any money or other consideration in connection with the dismissal of your petition for rule making for Binger, Oklahoma.

Prior to receipt of your motion to dismiss, a Commission engineering analysis determined that your proposal was unacceptable as filed. Although Channel 283A could be allotted to Binger at your requested site and the downgrade of Station KMGL accomplished at its current site, the alternate site you selected for vacant Channel 283C1 at Mooreland was unusable due to terrain problems. Should you decide to refile the proposal for Binger, Oklahoma City and Mooreland, you will need to provide site certification for Channel 283C1 at Mooreland.


In accordance with this request, no further action will be taken on the proposal to allot Channel 283A at Binger, Oklahoma.

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 283A at Binger, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 283A to Binger, Oklahoma as that community's first local FM service. Binger is an incorporated community with its own zip code and a population of 708 persons.¹ Binger has its own Mayor, Chalkie Opitz, its own fire department, police department, Spencer Davis Chief of Police, post office, city hall and a number of local churches. Binger is a community that is certainly deserving of local FM service. The proposed channel 283A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Binger residents and therefore is in the public interest.

In order for Channel 283A to be allotted at Binger, Oklahoma, station KMGL Channel 281C in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma will need to be reclassified to a C0. Pursuant to MM Docket 98-93, I am making a formal request for station KMGL in Oklahoma City to be reclassified from a C to a C0. (See, Attachment A, Request to Reclassify statement). Additionally, the reference coordinates for the vacant

allotment at Mooreland, Oklahoma, Channel 283C1, will need to be relocated approximately 46.8 kilometers northwest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 283A can be allocated to Binger, Oklahoma, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules, provided the changes are made at Oklahoma City and Mooreland, Oklahoma. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment B)

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that the reference coordinates for the vacant allotment at Mooreland, Texas, Channel 283C1, can be relocated 46.8 kilometers northwest consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. 



Radio Station KMGL(FM), Oklahoma City, Oklahoma is licensed to Renda Broadcasting Corporation of Nevada, 900 Parish St , 4th Floor, Pittsburgh, PA 15220, (Facility ID 55708), FCC File No BLH 19820830AH The facility operates with a power of 100 kilowatts with center of radiation 415 meters height above average terrain The above captioned Docket 98-93 provides the mechanism to automatically downgrade a Class C facility to Class C0 when a demand is made for the spectrum, as is the case here Charles Crawford respectfully requests that the license of Radio Station KMGL (FM) be modified to specify operation on FM Channel 281C0 instead of on FM Channel 281C in accordance with the above Docket which provides for such downgrades when a demand for the unused spectrum is made, as is the case here




