ORDER

On November 4, 2003, a Joint Request for Dismissal was filed by Voice in the Wilderness Broadcasting, Inc. and by Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc. ("Applicant Parties")

The Applicant Parties seek dismissal, without prejudice, of assignment of license of FM Station KCOL-FM, Groves, Texas, because the Applicant Parties do not wish to prosecute the assignment application at this time.¹ The Joint Request also requests that the instant hearing be terminated.

The Applicant Parties further represent that the Investigations and Hearings Division of the Enforcement Bureau has no objection.

Accordingly, there being no objection, IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Request for Dismissal IS GRANTED
