Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday afternoon, Charles Naftalin, Julie Murphy and I, all representing AT&T Alascom, met with Deena Shetler, Judith Nitsche, Douglas Sloten, Julie Saulnier, and Carol Canteen from the Wireline Competition Bureau, to discuss certain matters relevant to the above referenced Docket. In that discussion, Alascom's representatives informed the staff that during the course of the preparation of Transmittal No. 1281 to Alascom's FCC Tariff No. 11, filed November 25, 2003, it was determined that two inadvertent errors may have affected the rates submitted in Transmittal No. 1278, and that one of those errors likely affected rates on file and in effect for 2002 and earlier in 2003.

Alascom's representatives informed the staff that precise calculations of rate differences would be available within, approximately, two weeks and such calculations would be provided to the staff. Alascom's representatives also described a proposed mechanism to support prompt refunds to effected Tariff No. 11 customers as necessary.
