On December 12, 2003, James Robbins, President and CEO of Cox Communications, Michael Willner, President and CEO of Insight Communications, Patrick Butler, Vice President of The Washington Post Company, Alexander Netchvolodoff, Senior Vice President of Public Policy for Cox Enterprises, Bertram W. Carp, Bruce D. Sokler, and the undersigned, on behalf of Advance Newhouse, Cable One, Cox Communications, and Insight Communications ("Joint Cable Commenters"), met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, and, separately, with Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy and Jennifer Manner, Senior Counsel to Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy, concerning the possible remedies and conditions that are currently under consideration in connection with News Corp's proposed acquisition of a controlling interest in Hughes/DirecTV. We stressed the importance of crafting remedies that effectively address the applicants' post-transaction incentives to withhold or threaten to withhold must-have Fox broadcast and regional sports network content as a means of extracting supracompetitive prices for such programming from competing MVPDs.
