Mr. Seah is a director of StarHub Pte Ltd (“StarHub”), a Singapore telecommunications carrier, and is a commissioner (equivalent to a director) of PT Indonesian Satellite Corporation Tbk (“Indosat”), an Indonesian telecommunications carrier. Mr. Lee also is a director of StarHub and a commissioner of Indosat. None of the other directors of New GCL, and none of the officers of New GCL, is a director or officer of a foreign carrier as defined by 47 C.F.R. § 63.09(d).]

The majority of the directors and officers of New GCL’s Submarine Cable Subsidiaries and International Section 214 Subsidiaries (as defined in the *Order and Authorization*) also are directors and officers of New GCL. Accordingly, they have the interlocking directorates described above. To the extent other individuals are officers or directors of the Submarine Cable Subsidiaries or the International Section 214 Subsidiaries, they are not officers or directors of foreign carriers.
