To Withdraw ONA Services, WC Docket No. 02-355

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 15, 2002, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed a Petition seeking permission to withdraw three Open Network Architecture ("ONA") services currently listed as Basic Serving Arrangements in Qwest's ONA User's Guide and its Annual ONA Report. The three services Qwest requested to withdraw were Dataphone Select-a-Station, Digital Data Service 2-Wire ("DDS2-Wire") and Qwest IDSL. Qwest's Petition also referenced a Complementary Network Service, ScanAlert, and noted that permission to withdraw Complementary Network Services was not required under the Commission's rules. If the Commission disagreed, permission to withdraw ScanAlert was also requested. The Petition was publicly noticed on November 14, 2002.¹ No comments were filed.

The purpose of this letter is to amend Qwest's October 15, 2002 Petition in one respect. Specifically, permission is no longer requested to discontinue Qwest IDSL service. Accordingly, the Petition now requests permission only to withdraw the services Dataphone Select-a-Station and DDS2-Wire.
