RE: In Band On Channel (IBOC) Radio and The Kahn Petition (Docket 99-325)

Dear FCC Commissioners and Staff,

On July 2, 2003, 12 individuals and institutions filed in FCC Docket 99-325 a letter which called for action on a Petition For Rulemaking by Leonard Kahn, P.E. of KAHN COMMUNICATIONS in New York State.

On August 28, Tracey Devlin of New York asked to be recorded in this Docket as an additional Kahn Petition supporter. This brought the total number of signatories to 13. Now, the following individual has also asked to be recorded in FCC Docket 99-325 as one of "Kahn's Crusaders":

The Kahn Petition seeks review, testing and evaluation of the AM-Compatible Digital Radio (CAM-D) technology that KAHN COMMUNICATIONS has recently developed. According to Mr. Kahn, CAM-D technology permits Digital Radio broadcasts on the AM Band *without* causing the interference associated with IBOC Digital Radio.

The Kahn Petition also urges the FCC to suspend its current authorization of "interim" IBOC broadcasts, pending review, testing and evaluation of the CAM-D alternative.

"Kahn's Crusaders" again ask the FCC to proceed with action on the Kahn Petition.
