Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter amends the above-referenced application, filed December 31, 2003, to make clear that the application pertains to Qwest LD Corp. ("QLDC"), a wholly owned affiliate of Qwest Communications International Inc. ("QCII"), in addition to the other Qwest affiliates included in the original filing.

The application, at page 10, stated that Allegiance Services customers, assets and facilities located within the Qwest local service region will be divided between QCC and QC in order to maintain Qwest's compliance with Section 272 of the Telecommunications Act. In addition, certain Allegiance Services customers located within the Qwest local service region will be assigned to QLDC, also in compliance with Section 272 of the Act. (As provided in the application, all of the Allegiance Services customers, assets and facilities located outside the Qwest local service territory will be assigned to QCC.)

QLDC is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 1801 California Street, Denver, Colorado 80202. It is a direct wholly owned subsidiary of Qwest Services Corporation ("QSC"). Thus, its ownership and foreign affiliations are the same as those of QCC. QLDC is authorized to provide interstate and international telecommunications services pursuant to Section 214. See Public Notice, DA 02-3598, IB File No. ITC-214-20021009-00495 (Dec. 26, 2002) (granting international Section 214 authority). QLDC currently provides and intends to

continue to provide international telecommunications services between the United States and all international points. It has no interlocking directorates with foreign carriers.

A revised Exhibit B, listing relevant FCC-certificated subsidiaries of Qwest, is attached to this letter to reflect QLDC as well as additional international Section 214 authorizations held by QCC.
