Abernathy and her Legal Adviser on Media Issues, Stacy Robinson Fuller; Commissioner Michael J. Copps and his Senior Legal Advisor, Jordan Goldstein; Commissioner Kevin J. Martin and his Legal Advisor on Media Issues, Catherine Crutcher Bohigian; and Jonathan Cody, Media Advisor and Special Policy Counsel to Chairman Michael K. Powell, to discuss cable carriage of digital television broadcast signals.


The positions expressed in these meetings were consistent with Univision's Comments and Reply Comments in this proceeding. Specifically, Univision advocated that the Commission mandate carriage of digital and analog signals during the transition to digital television, described the importance of such carriage to local broadcast stations, and discussed the constitutionality and public interest benefits of such carriage.
