Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 6, Vonya McCann, Dick Juhnke and I met with Commissioner Martin and Daniel Gonzalez to discuss AT&T's petition for declaratory ruling regarding its phone-to-phone IP telephony service, and US LEC's petition for declaratory ruling regarding LEC access charges for CMRS traffic. Sprint reiterated points made in our filings in these proceedings, and urged the Commission to act expeditiously on both of these petitions. Sprint also advised that SBC's claim, in a February 3 *ex parte* submission, that 40% of Sprint's traffic had migrated to an IP network was grossly overstated, and that our actual VoIP traffic volume using alternative terminating arrangements has been, to date, minimal.

I request that this letter, which is being filed electronically, be placed in the file for the above-captioned proceedings.
