

**VERIZON VIRGINIA INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE AMENDMENTS TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENTS**


Verizon Virginia Inc ("Verizon VA") hereby moves for a thirty-day extension of the February 9, 2004, deadline for the parties to file amendments to their interconnection agreements to incorporate the rates set forth in the Bureau's January 29, 2004, *Compliance Order* in this proceeding. Both WorldCom, Inc ("WorldCom") and AT&T Communications of Virginia, LLC ("AT&T") consent to the relief sought in this motion.

The Bureau's *Compliance Order* provides the parties ten days to memorialize the results of the order in amendments to the Verizon/WorldCom and Verizon/AT&T interconnection agreements and file those amendments with the Bureau. However, translating the ordered rates into amendments to the interconnection agreements is not merely a mechanical exercise. In a

number of cases, the parties must determine, and agree on, how to apply the ordered rates in the context of the rate structures and other terms in their agreements and whether those related terms themselves require some changes. Verizon VA is in the process of making those determinations now and expects to provide AT&T and WorldCom with proposed amendments by February 13, 2004. The parties will then engage in any required negotiations concerning those proposals and submit the resulting amendments to the Bureau by March 10, 2004. This extension does not affect the effective date of the rates, which remains as set forth in paragraph 42 of the *Compliance Order*.

For the foregoing reasons, Verizon VA's unopposed Motion For Extension should be granted.


