**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW PETITION OF CELLULAR MOBILE
SYSTEMS OF ST. CLOUD, LLC FOR LIMITED WAIVER AND EXTENSION OF ITS
PORTING AND POOLING OBLIGATIONS**

Cellular Mobile Systems of St. Cloud, LLC (“CMS”), by its attorneys, and pursuant to Section 1.41 of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”), hereby seeks leave to withdraw its Petition for Limited Waiver and Extension of its Porting and Pooling Obligations (“Petition”) and requests that the Commission dismiss the Petition without prejudice.

On September 25, 2003, CMS submitted the above-referenced Petition with the FCC requesting an extension until May 24, 2004 to implement wireless Local Number Portability (“WLNP”) in the St. Cloud, Minnesota Metropolitan Statistical Area (“MSA”). Subsequent to filing its Petition, CMS continued its efforts in preparation of the deployment of WLNP and became LNP capable. In addition, it now appears that other carriers within the market have now implemented WLNP. As a result, CMS’s Petition is moot.

For the foregoing reasons, CMS respectfully requests that the Commission grant CMS leave to withdraw its Petition and dismiss the Petition without prejudice.
