**ORDER**

On January 30, 2004, a Joint Request for Dismissal was filed by Mountain Wireless, Inc. and by Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc. ("Applicant Parties").

The Applicant Parties seek withdrawal and dismissal, without prejudice, of applications to assign the licenses of AM Station WSKW and FM Station WHOQO, Showhegan, Maine.<sup>1</sup>

The Applicant Parties have advised in the Joint Request that the Investigations and Hearings Division of the Enforcement Bureau has no objection to a grant of this request.

Accordingly, there being no objection, IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Request for Dismissal IS GRANTED.


