REQUEST TO WITHDRAW PETITION

On June 16, 2003, ALLTEL Communications, Inc. (“ALLTEL”), AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. (“AWS”), the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association (“CTIA”) and Cingular Wireless LLC (“Cingular”) filed the above-captioned Expedited Petition for Rulemaking to Rescind the CMRS LNP Rule (“Petition to Rescind”). The Commission sought public comment on the petition on September 16, 2003.¹

On February 11, 2004, ALLTEL, AWS, and CTIA filed a letter in CC Docket No. 95-116 requesting their withdrawal from the Petition to Rescind. Thus, Cingular is the only remaining party to the Petition to Rescind.
