Dear Secretary Dortch:

Allegiance Telecom, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession (“Allegiance”), and Qwest Communications International Inc. (“Qwest,” and, together with Allegiance, the “Applicants”), by their attorneys, respectfully submit this letter to advise the Commission that the proposed transaction between the Applicants, whereby Qwest proposed to purchase substantially all of the regulated assets of Allegiance’s operating subsidiaries (the “Transaction”), will be terminated.

The Transaction was in furtherance of the reorganization of Allegiance under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. Pursuant to procedures adopted by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the “Bankruptcy Court”), on February 12, 2004, Allegiance commenced an auction for the sale of its assets. On February 13th, Allegiance announced that XO Communications Inc. (“XO”) had submitted the highest bid in the auction, and the Bankruptcy Court confirmed XO as the winner on February 19th.

Because Qwest was not confirmed as the winning bidder, Applicants intend to terminate the Transaction. Accordingly, Applicants respectfully request that the Commission dismiss without prejudice Applicants’ Joint Application for Consent to Assignment of Assets, which was filed on December 31, 2003, in the above-referenced docket. Further, to the extent the Commission obtained confidential or proprietary information with respect to the Transaction from the Department of Justice, Applicants respectfully request that such information be treated in accordance with the HSR waiver letter sent to the Department of Justice on January 27, 2004, and filed with the Commission that same day.


