I am thrilled to report the 2000 TCU Latin American Music Festival surpassed all expectations, thanks in large part to the marketing support by Ch. 23 Univision. 3,660 people attended 12 events over three days . . . an 83% increase over attendance from the first festival held in 1998 (which featured 14 events over two days).

Attendance at the three major concerts was at least double what it was in 1998. We attribute this directly to our advertising efforts. (Germán commented he had seen television spot several times.) Even more important in our minds was the makeup of the audiences, of which a significant percentage was Hispanic. As that was one of our primary goals -- to increase awareness of the event among the Latino communities in North Texas -- we are even more satisfied with the results. The best-attended event was Friday night's concert, which was more "popular" in nature than the other two concerts. We believe this indicates a widespread desire in this community for a significant Latin cultural celebration, something we will discuss in depth this summer as we look ahead to the 2002 festival.

Thank you again for supporting the TCU Latin American Music Festival. We'll keep you abreast of plans for 2002.
