



WOW! The 2003 "Rock 'n Roll Up Your Sleeve" blood drive conducted June 27 – July 5 was a resounding success. 1689 units were donated at the area malls during this period, and 577 donors came to our facilities and donated as a response to the KLOL effort. This brings the total units donated during the above period to 2,266. As usual, we'll keep the drive open until the end of the month and advise you of the total results at that time.

These donations represent a 73% increase over last year's "Rock and Roll Up Your Sleeve" blood drive, or an additional 961 units. Primarily because of this outstanding effort, we had an adequate blood supply over the July 4th holiday, and on behalf of the patients who directly benefited from your generosity, please accept our heartfelt gratitude.
